It's a Good Thing!

Our goal is to provide scholarships to members helping them maintain and upgrade their professional management skills & to enhance opportunities for all MVVMA members through shared experiences!

How much of a good thing you ask?!

Award recipient(s) may receive funds of up to 75% of the cost of the membership and/or training registration they are seeking assistance toward.

Who qualifies?

Scholarship applicants are required to be current MVVMA members (either individual or organization) with length of membership of one full year.

How can I use the funds? How can they be applied?

Tuition (registration) scholarships may be awarded to attend conferences, seminars, workshops, symposia, classes, or for other beneficial educational experiences. Scholarship funds may not be applied to lodging, meals or transportation costs.

How can I apply? What do I have to do?

Applications are available year round. Applicants can request an application from the MVVMA Executive Committee Secretary in person and/or by email information@mvvma.org or by contacting the Scholarship Committee members. The form is also available online at www.mvvma.org/membership. The completed form can be hand delivered and/or sent to committee by mail. *Scholarship recipients will be required to share information with the MVVMA members through written or oral presentations within 6 months of attending the event.* It is the scholarship recipient's responsibility to contact Vice President to determine the best way to facilitate this requirement.

How it works!

Scholarship Committee Review Process: The vice-president and two members serve as the scholarship committee. MVVMA members may volunteer to serve on the committee or may be asked by the vice-president. The committee meets as necessary to make decisions on awards. Awards are determined by committee and based on request and availability of funds within 30 days of receipt of application request on a first come first serve basis.
